

KISWAHILI PROGRAM FOR FOREIGNERS

Sokoine University of Agriculture (SUA) is a Public University based in Morogoro Tanzania. The university is located on the slopes of the Uluguru Mountains.

SUA is best known for offering courses and programmes widely in a field of Agriculture, Veterinary Science, Forestry, Animal Science, Wildlife Management, Tourism Management, Environmental Science, Food Science, Natural Resources, Nutrition, Rural Development, since its establishment.

SUACAIL has been a hub of offering professionally designed face-to-face and online programmes to learners of international languages within and outside SUA. COURSE OFFERED

Beginners Kiswahili (15 modules, 20Hours per module)

Upper-Intermediate Kiswahili (15 modules, 20Hours per module)

The courses aim to enable the learners to engage in Swahili communications. The courses cover all aspects of Kiswahili grammar and culture.

TEACHING/LEARNING METHOD

The teaching follows American Council on the teaching of foreign languages (ACTFL). It is a learner-centered approach where learners interact with authentic material. The program also integrate study visits to different sites and cultural places such as Ruaha National Park, Mikumi national park, Bagamoyo and Zanzibar. The visits make learners practice the language learnt.

ASSESSMENT AND CERTIFICATION

The courses are assessed through quizzes, tests and oral exam. The student who passes will be certified with certificate that indicates the module passed.
